**ST. JAMES WAY**  
**NORTHERN WAY FROM BAAMONDE TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA**  
(The last 100 kms)  
**7 DAYS**



**Day 1. Arrival at Baamonde.**

Once you arrive at Baamonde, be sure you visit Saint James Church, of Romanesque style. You can also see a unique piece of art, a chapel carved into the interior of a 500-year old chestnut tree, located next to the parish church. **Accommodation in Baamonde.**

**Day 2. Stage 1: Baamonde – Miraz (15,2 km)**

**Breakfast in Baamonde.**

You will start walking an easy stage, passing by small villages like San Breixo de Parga, Carballedo, Seixón and A Lagoa. Then, you will finally arrive at Miraz, where you will be able to visit the tower of Miraz, an ancient fortress from the XV century. **Accommodation in Miraz.**

**Day 3. Stage 2: Miraz – Sobrado dos Monxes (26 km)**

**Breakfast in Miraz.**

After breaking, you will be leaving Miraz, walking towards Sobrado dos Monxes. In this village, you will get the chance to visit the astonishing Monastery of Santa María, managed by Benedictine monks.

**Accommodation in Sobrado dos Monxes.**

**Day 4. Stage 3: Sobrado Dos Monxes – Arzúa (21,4 km)**

**Breakfast in Sobrado dos Monxes.**

This time, you will be walking the last stage of the Northern Way before joining the French Way in Arzúa. In this town, you can visit some places like the Convent of Magdalena and the Church of Santiago.

**Accommodation in Arzúa.**

#### **Day 5. Stage 4: Arzúa – O Pedrouzo (19 km)**

##### **Breakfast in Arzúa.**

Soon before arriving at Santiago, you will finish this stage in O Pedrouzo, belonging to the O Pino “concello”. Here you will find the memorable Chapel of Santa Irene. **Accommodation in O Pedrouzo.**

#### **Day 6. Stage 5: O Pedrouzo – Santiago de Compostela (20 km)**

##### **Breakfast in O Pedrouzo.**

Ready for the last stage, you will leave O Pedrouzo heading to Santiago de Compostela. Once in Santiago, you will be surrounded by many landmarks. The main points of interest are the Cathedral and the Square of Obradoiro, but that does not mean those are the only remarkable places, as it is also recommendable to take a stroll around the historic district, to taste the gastronomy and to visit some other iconic buildings such as the Catholic Monarchs Inn, the Monastery of San Martín Pinarío or the Pazo of Raxoi.

**Accommodation in Santiago de Compostela.**

#### **Day 7. Breakfast in Santiago de Compostela and end of services.**
